  - Before getting started, download the Zoom application from **Zoom's website**.
  - After the Zoom application has been downloaded and installed, <u>open the Zoom</u> <u>application</u>.
  - Once the application has been opened, follow <u>these simple instructions</u> to get started.
- iPad or iPhone
  - Download the Zoom Cloud Meetings app from the <u>App Store</u>.
  - After the Zoom application has been downloaded, follow these simple instructions to learn how to <u>Sign In and Join a meeting</u>.
