Re: Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook South IHSA Bass Fishing State Tournament

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of Education ratify the Superintendent's authorization for an overnight trip for Glenbrook South students to participate in the IHSA Bass Fishing State Tournament, May 19, 2022 through May 21, 2022 in Carlyle, Illinois.

## **Background**

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Mr. Justin Zummo and Mr. Brian Schmalzer shared in their memo, two students from Glenbrook South qualified for the bass fishing IHSA state tournament this month. Due to the timing of this trip, Dr. Johns previously approved this trip under the provision of Board Policy 7230 that states, "The Superintendent has authority to approve certain overnight trips in extenuating circumstances (e.g., IHSA qualifying state series), subject to Board ratification. At this time, we are requesting that the Board of Education ratify the trip that took place on Thursday, May 19, 2022 through Saturday, May 21, 2022 in Carlyle, Illinois.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

Dear Board of Education,

Below is a proposal for the IHSA Bass Fishing State Conference in Carlyle, IL. This year's tournament takes place on May 19th-21st, 2022. As the trip requires overnight travel, I am requesting approval for our state qualifying students and chaperones to attend the competition.

The State Tournament takes place on Carlyle Lake in Carlyle, IL. Students are allowed to pre-fish on Thursday (19th) and then the tournament happens over the next 2 days, Friday (20th) and Saturday (21st). They will be tasked with putting together a limit of 5 fish on both days of the tournament for a 2-day total weight in order to decide who will be the winner. We will need to leave on Thursday morning to travel down to Carlyle so that we can pre-fish the afternoon to get our bearings. When the tournament is over on Saturday afternoon we will load up and head home.

The cost allocation worksheet is attached to this proposal.

**COVID Mitigation:** Per the District 225 travel policy, one student per bed. It is also recommended that participants Covid test prior to travel, and not attend the tournament if the test is positive.
