Re: Resolution Authorizing Management of Workers' Compensation Claims

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the Resolution Authorizing Management of Workers' Compensation Claims.

Background

Glenbrook High School District 225 is a member of the Secondary School Cooperative Risk Management Program (SSCRMP), a risk sharing insurance pool that includes three other high school districts (207, 211, 214). One of the functions of the pool is to provide workers' compensation insurance coverage to all member districts. As a part of this function, the pool has retained the law firm of Wiedner & McAuliffe, Ltd. to represent the District and the pool in claim processing and litigation. In an effort to expedite lower cost workers' compensation settlements, it is recommended that the Board of Education authorize the administration to approve settlements in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

The attached resolution authorizes the law firm of Wiedner & McAuliffe, Ltd., or other firm selected by SSCRMP to respond to and negotiate resolution of claims and threatened claims against the District. Approval of this resolution allows for intervention into any and all applicable workers' compensation proceedings, and authorizes the firm to execute any negotiated settlements which are consistent with the Board's interests as authorized by the Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources or Superintendent.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MANAGEMENT OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIMS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Workers' Compensation Act ("Act") (820 ILCS 305/1 *et seq.*), employees of the School District are entitled to and do pursue claims for remedies for work-related injuries; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the District, without retaliation, is entitled to and does appropriately respond to claims for remedies under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to authorize legal counsel and the Superintendent to manage its responses to certain claims under the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Northfield Township High School District No. 225, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The Board hereby finds that all the recitals contained above are true and correct, and that the same are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The Board hereby authorizes the law firm of Wiedner & McAuliffe, Ltd., or such other lawyer or law firm as selected by the District's authorized workers' compensation insurance carrier, as its legal representative to: (1) appear on behalf of the District in matters pending before the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission and represent the Board's interests in such matters, (2) respond to and negotiate tentative resolution of claims and threatened claims against the District under the Act, pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Superintendent and consistent with the Board's interests; and (3) advise the Board and the administration as to the management of claims under the Act.

Section 3: The Board hereby authorizes the Superintendent or Superintendent's designee, under the supervision of the Board and upon consultation with legal counsel, to execute the settlement of any claim under the Act which would involve a total compensation payment of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or less.

Section 4: All motions and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and shall
remain in effect until action by this Board to modify or rescind it on an annual basis.
After a full and complete discussion thereof, Member moved that the
foregoing Resolution be adopted and Member seconded the motion. The
President directed the Secretary to call the roll for a vote upon the motion to adopt this
Resolution. Upon a roll call vote being taken, the Board of Education voted as follows:
