Recommendation

I recommend that the Board of Education approve the final 2017-2018 school year calendar.

Background

The final school calendar is to be submitted to the Regional Office of Education no later than the last day of school.

Included in our annual school year calendar are ten “emergency days” intended to be used if an emergency, usually weather related, compels us to close both of our schools and extend the school year. Each year the Board of Education is asked to revise the school calendar by deleting the unused emergency days and thereby establishing a new closing date.

After the makeup of the lost day due to inclement weather the end-of-year calendar is as follows:

- The emergency day scheduled for January 12 was not needed, so it became a non-in-attendance (NIA) day for students
- February 9 which was an emergency day(ED) due to inclement weather, was made up on April 2 as a student attendance day (X)
- **The last day of school for seniors is Friday, June 1 as scheduled**
- Graduation dates for both schools will remain on Sunday, June 3 as scheduled
- **The tentative last day of school for students in grades 9, 10, and 11 is Wed., June 6 as scheduled**

The final school calendar is to be submitted to the Regional Office of Education no later than the last day of school.
