Re: Award of Bids for the Expanded Glenbrook North Student Activity Hallway Renovations

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education award the bids as presented in Table 1 for renovations to the Glenbrook North Student Activity Hallway to be completed during the summer of 2023 for \$358,150.

## **Background**

At the Monday, March 13, 2023 meeting, expanded renovations to the Glenbrook North student activity hallway were discussed. Renovations include new carpeting, upgraded lighting and ceiling tile, new radiator covers, furniture, acoustical panels, and theming design. Bid specifications were sent to prospective vendors on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, and bids were opened on Thursday, March 30, 2023. Overall, bid results are \$30,350, or 8% less than the original estimate. As a reminder, bids for items included in the original scope, which included standard ceiling tile, standard lighting, and HVAC upgrades, were awarded at the March 20, 2023, meeting for \$311,125.

## **Glenbrook North Student Activity Hallway**

The leadership team has been working with Arcon Associates to improve the overall student experience by identifying common student areas throughout the buildings to modernize and elevate. The student activity hallway at Glenbrook North has been identified as a prime area based on its high volume of student traffic, the natural light from the courtyard, its proximity to the student activity center, and the sheer number of students congregating in the space between classes.

The recommended design concept incorporates the following components to create a student-centered space with character and a unique identity:

• Ceiling and Lighting - As part of the recommended Summer 2023 capital projects, the SA ceiling and lighting are slated for replacement. The base bid, awarded on March 20, 2023, included the replacement of the original spline ceiling and fluorescent lighting with a traditional drop ceiling grid system and LED lighting, and HVAC upgrades.

An alternate bid was created to capture the incremental cost of upgrading the ceiling tile and lighting. This includes maintaining the standard 2x2 ceiling grid but using an upgraded ceiling tile with a cleaner, smoother finish. Additionally, upgraded linear lighting is recommended to give the overall space less of an institutional look.

- Furniture Creates seating options that appeal to various student interests, offer choices such as a place to perch for a few minutes, sit alone to engage in focused study and create clusters for groups of various sizes to work together.
- Flooring Uses flooring to create permeable boundaries and define seating areas.
- Acoustical panels Gives visual interest while providing acoustic properties.
- Branding Includes the use of graphics throughout the space.
