Re: Chromebook Recommendation for Class of 2020

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Education:

- 1. Approve the purchase of 1,350 3rd generation Lenovo 11e Yoga Chromebook devices for the incoming freshman Class of 2020 at a unit price not to exceed \$369 and a total purchase price not to exceed \$498,150.
- 2. Maintain the \$110 annual Chromebook fee.
- 3. Maintain the self-insurance program with adjusted deductible as listed on page 2.

Lenovo 3rd Generation 11e Yoga Chromebook

The Educational Technology staff performed preliminary research of chromebooks for class of 2020 with the characteristics of durability, functionality, flexibility in the learning space, and price in mind. During the months of February and March ten students - five from each school - ranging from freshmen through juniors field tested four different chromebooks from Acer, Dell, HP, and Lenovo. After gaining input from Educational and Technical Service teams and students, the chromebook being recommended is the same device the current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors have with the exception being the 3rd Generation model (released March 2016) has a longer battery life, and increased processing speed. The device price includes a standard 1-year warranty.

Annual Fee - \$110

The annual chromebook fee of \$110 has been assessed for the previous two school years, and it is recommended that it remain.

Student Fee Collected Over 4-years \$440
Upfront District Cost for Device \$369

\$71 - (\$17.75 per year - used to fund the self-insurance pool)

As a point of comparison, the market premium for a family to purchase individual insurance of this nature is \$60 a year, while the premium to the district to insure the device with a third party is \$32 a year.
