RE: Proposed 2009 Tax Levy

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the *Resolution Regarding the Estimated Amounts Necessary to be Levied for the Year 2009*, as well as the Notice of Proposed Tax Increase, in compliance with the Truth in Taxation Act.

Background

Historically, the tax levy is calculated using the applicable Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers, plus an adequate percentage allocation for new growth within the district. For the 2009 tax levy, we are recommending that the board adopt a levy that is 2.1% higher than the 2008 extension for tax cap funds. We are asking for a slightly higher levy to take into account any property designated as new growth. Unfortunately, we do not receive any data on new construction until the following August. Since any increase above the current tax cap CPI of .1% is due to new construction, levying 2.1% would in no way affect the property tax bill for current property owners. It will, however, allow us to capture all of the new growth within our tax base.

By law, since the tax cap levy we are recommending is less than 5% over the past year's tax extension, the district is NOT required to publish notice and conduct a public hearing on the proposed 2009 Tax Levy as outlined in the Truth in Taxation Act.

RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ESTIMATED AMOUTS NECESSARY TO BE LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2009

WHEREAS, the Truth in Taxation Law requires that all taxing districts determine the estimated amounts of taxes necessary to be levied for the year not less than twenty (20) days prior to the adoption of the aggregate tax levy of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Law requires that public notice be given and a public hearing be held if the district intends to adopt an aggregate tax levy in an amount which is more than 105% of the amount extended or estimated to be extended upon the final aggregate levy extensions, plus any amount abated, exclusive of election costs, for the preceding year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education for Glenbrook High School District 225, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The aggregate amount of taxes, estimated to be levied for the year 2009, is \$86,449,630 exclusive of levies for bond and interest and including estimated levies for specific purposes as follows:

Transportation	\$250,000
IMRF	\$250,000

Working Cash	\$850,000

Section 2. The amount of taxes estimated to be levied or to have already been levied for bond and interest purposes for the year 2009 is \$7,288,558.

<u>Section 3.</u> If required, the administration shall cause an appropriate public notice to be published and a public hearing to be scheduled on the levy.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
