### **Recommendation**

The administration is asking for the Board to approve the [attached list of recommended textbook changes for next year that was presented for the Board's preliminary review at the February 28, 2022 Board meeting.](#)

### **Textbook Adoption Process and Timeline**

The examination of current texts is part of the curriculum review process to assure appropriate, relevant and engaging materials for our students. Requests have been proposed by teachers and were reviewed by Instructional Supervisors and Associate Principals. New texts may be requested based on the availability of digital resources, addition of new courses, and updates of curricular resources. While this compilation contains the majority of textbook changes, we may bring to the Board a limited number of texts in mid-summer as a result of summer curriculum projects.

### **Background**

Textbook changes are based upon Board Policy 7180 and Board Procedures 7180, which we are in the process of updating. As a reminder, textbook pricing is no longer a part of the Textbook Approval Process, but will be reviewed during the Registration and Instructional Materials Fee for the 2022-2023 school year at an upcoming board meeting.
