**RE:** Discussion Regarding Student Fees for 2009 – 2010 School Year

Attached are the recommended student fees for the 2009 – 2010 school year. We are recommending no increase for student fees, with the exception of student transportation fees and parking sticker fees.

**Student Transportation**

For the 2009/10 school year we are recommending an increase in student transportation fees equal to 11.4%. This increase is necessary to maintain transportation on a non-subsidy basis. This is a factor of projected ridership as well as a 1/10 % increase in rates from First Student.

- Registration period will run from April 6<sup>th</sup> – June 5<sup>th</sup>
- After June 5<sup>th</sup>, seats will be offered on a “space available basis” and based on existing stops and routes
- No new routes will be added after June 5<sup>th</sup>
- As has been common practice, we will offer a \$25 discount for anyone registering via the Internet

In 2008/09 the board approved a revision to Section C, #10 of Board Policy Procedures 8230: Food Service and School Aid for Children of Low Income Families, which allows for a 50% reduction PER FAMILY for the cost of a bus pass for those families that qualify as “reduced” when applying for financial aid.

**Parking Sticker Fees**

We are recommending an increase of \$10 for the parking sticker fees. This reflects the cost increase of salaries for parking lot supervision.

Please note: with the exception of student transportation, parking and preschool, this is the second year in a row that there has been no increase in fees.

**For Consideration**

Due to economic conditions, which have affected some of our Glenbrook families, we could consider waiving the towel and materials fee for 1 year, saving each student \$25.50. The cost to the district would be \$119,850.
