# Calendar Survey Analysis

Prepared for Glenbrook High School District 225

November 2018





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### Introduction

- In this report, Hanover Research (Hanover) presents findings from our analysis of Glenbrook High School District 225's (GHSD) Calendar Survey. The survey instrument, designed collaboratively by Hanover and GHSD, assesses key GHSD stakeholders' perceptions of changing the school calendar from a traditional to a collegiate calendar, and how changes may impact families and school staff.
- Surveys were distributed to current GHSD students and parents/guardians, parents/guardians of GHSD feeder school students, and GHSD staff members via an email campaign. After removing low quality responses, severely limited responses, and disqualified responses, Hanover analyzed qualifying responses for a total sample of 7,707. A breakdown of respondents' stakeholder groups and high schools are shown in the figures below. For a breakdown of respondents by high school grade level, feeder school, feeder school grade level, feeder school district, and dual staff/parent role, please refer to the accompanying data supplement.

## Methodology

- In the following report, aggregate results and results segmented by stakeholder group are discussed in the Key Findings section and displayed in the Report Figures section. For full aggregate and segmented results by stakeholder group, high school, high school grade level, feeder school, feeder school grade level, feeder school district, and dual staff/parent role, please consult the accompanying data supplement. These data highlight instances where there are statistically significant differences between stakeholder groups (indicated with an asterisk [\*]).
- Note that sample sizes vary across questions as some questions only pertain to a subset of respondents (e.g., students). Conclusions drawn from a small sample size (n<20) should be interpreted with caution. Throughout the analysis, "Does Not Apply to Me" or "No Opinion" responses, and equivalent, are excluded from the figures and analysis in order to focus on respondents who did express an opinion.
- In the survey, 1,262 respondents indicated that they were a parent of both a child attending a Glenbrook High School and a child attending a Glenbrook feeder school. For these respondents, they were asked to select one child to complete the survey for. A percentage breakdown of these respondents is shown in the figure below.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**



#### Recommendations

- GHSD should consider adopting the Option 1 calendar (i.e., earlier school start and end dates and final exams scheduled prior to winter break) for its high schools. The survey results indicate that more than half of all stakeholders (students, staff, and parents) prefer to have final exams taken prior to winter break. Students prefer the Option 1 calendar, and while school staff slightly prefer the Option 2 calendar, they also indicate that the Option 1 schedule would not adversely impact their classroom and curriculum planning. Most parents also indicate that the Option 1 schedule would not adversely affect family vacation planning and other activities.
- GHSD should secure buy-in from parents of GHSD feeder school students if the school district decides to adopt the Option 1 calendar. More than half of this group of parents prefer the Option 2 calendar over Option 1. GHSD should communicate to this group of parents the reasons that the district is considering shifting the calendar (e.g., aligns better with the flow of the curriculum). Parents of students in three schools in particular—Greenbriar (K-5), Lyon (PreK-5), and Pleasant Ridge (3-5)—do not prefer Option 1 because they believe that it will have a negative impact on their family vacation plans and other activities. GHSD may want to focus communication efforts on these parents in particular, and address the concerns they have about impact on their family schedules.
- Given that the majority of students report experiencing moderate-to-high levels of stress during most school weeks, GHSD should consider offering resources and supports that help students manage the stressors that they face in school. Some suggested resources and supports include offering specific trainings to students on effective time management and general strategies to cope with stress (e.g., taking breaks, engaging in physical exercise), and encouraging students to make use of the counseling services available at their school.



# **KEY FINDINGS**

### School Calendar Preference

- Students prefer the school calendar that has earlier school start and end dates (Option 1) while parents of Glenbrook feeder school students prefer later school start and end dates (Option 2) (see figure to the right). Staff members slightly prefer Option 2 (48%) over Option 1 (41%), while parents of Glenbrook High School students are almost evenly divided on the school calendar schedules (49% for Option 1 and 45% for Option 2).
- Three-quarters (76%) of respondents like the Option 1 schedule because it features a first-semester final exam that occurs prior to the winter break, while two-thirds (67%) like Option 2 because of the school start date that occurs in late August. Only 5 percent of respondents like the school start date of early-to mid-August that is featured in the Option 1 schedule, and just 18 percent like Option 2's date of first-semester exams that occur after winter break.



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## School Calendar Preference by Respondent Characteristics


Calendar preferences do not differ for students across the high school grade levels, but a few differences in preferences do emerge for feeder school parents by school and school district.

#### Students:

 Preferences are similar for students across the high school grade levels (between 52% and 61% of grades 9-12 students prefer Option 1).

#### **Feeder School Parents:**

- Preferences are similar for parents across feeder school grade levels (with Option 2 being preferred by parents at most grade levels).



Parents of children in schools at Northbrook District 28 and Glenville School District 34 have a clear preference for Option 2 while parents at the other three feeder school districts are closer to being evenly split between the two calendar schedules.


It appears that one of the main reasons why parents prefer Option 2 is because the schedule interferes less with their vacation plans and activities than Option 1. Of the parents with children at schools who prefer Option 2 the most, which includes Greenbriar (K-5), Lyon (PreK-2), and Pleasant Ridge (3-5), between 65% and 75% indicate that a move to Option 1 would have a "negative impact" on their family vacation plans and other activities.

## Impacts of Calendar Change on Parents and School Staff

- Overall, staff agree that a change from the Option 2 calendar to the Option 1 calendar would have a minimal and even a positive impact on their experiences.
  - The vast majority of staff indicate that the proposed calendar change would have no affect or a positive effect on professional development opportunities (90%), the flow of the curriculum (78%), the quality of winter break (76%), and on the return to school after winter break (77%).
  - Staff who report a negative effect indicate that the calendar change would have the most impact on grading time (48%) and class preparation time (43%).

The majority (73%) of school staff indicate that they would <u>not</u> need to change the format of their final exams if the school schedule were to change.

What impact would a move to the Option 1 calendar have on your household's vacation and other activities? (n=7,552)




Over half (56%) of parents indicate that a change in the school calendar would not adversely affect family vacation plans and activities.



### Impact of Changing Final Exam Schedule to Prior to Winter Break

- Approximately half of students indicate that ongoing academic and non-academic activities would have no or very little impact on final exam preparation if first-semester final exams were to be scheduled before winter break (see figure to the right). A plurality (46%) indicate that ongoing coursework would have "no" or just "a little" impact on their exam preparation, while 26 percent indicate coursework would have "somewhat" of an impact, and 28 percent indicate it would have "a lot" or "a great deal" of impact.
- The majority (53%) of respondents report that having exams after winter break compared to taking them before the break would be worse or much worse. Twenty-eight percent of respondents indicate taking exams after winter break would be better or much better.

Almost half (47%) of respondents indicate that involvement in non-academic activities would have "no" or just "a little" impact on exam preparation while 30 percent indicate it would have "somewhat" of an impact.

### Final Exams and Portfolio Work

- About two-thirds (63%) of students took final exams or submitted portfolio work in January during the 2017-2018 academic year and that coincides with the official exam schedule for that year.
  - Students report that they took or submitted, on average, five final exams or portfolio assignments in January 2018.
  - About a third (31%) of students took final exams or submitted portfolio work in December of the same academic year, indicating that some school staff/teachers have already shifted the exam schedule to prior to the winter break.


- Students report that out of the first semester courses they took that ended in December 2017/January 2018, they, on average,....
- ...completed about 2 alternative assessments rather than a final exam/portfolio assignment;
  - ...had 3 classes that assigned homework to be completed over winter break;
- ✓ ...had 3 classes that required a unit exam prior to winter break; and
- ✓ ...had 2 classes that required a project to be handed in prior to winter break.




## Final Exam Preparation and Stress Experienced


- Preparing for their first-semester final exams after winter break. Sixty-eight percent of students estimate spending 6 or more hours studying the weekend before the final exams while 53 percent report spending 6+ hours during exam week. Thirty-six percent report spending 6+ hours studying during winter break.
- Not surprisingly, the majority (59%) of students report experiencing significantly more stress during exam week. Most students report average or below average stress during winter break. Stress increases leading up to the week of exams, deceases during break, and increases again (to a lesser extent) for the first two weeks of the 2nd semester.

Thirty-nine percent of students begin preparing for first-semester final exams over winter break.




#### Which calendar-style do you prefer?





















## Taking First-Semester Final Exams After Winter Break


Do you think taking first-semester final exams <u>after Winter</u>

## To what extent is it important that feeder school schedules and high school schedules align? (n=5,165)
















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
How many of your first semester courses ending in December 2017/January 2018 required both an alternative end-of-term project or take-home test and a semester final exam/portfolio at the end of the semester?




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
How many of your first semester courses ending in December 2017/January 2018 required homework to be completed over winter break? (n=1,550)


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





How many of your first semester courses ending in December 2017/January 2018 required a project (not portfolio) to be handed in immediately prior to winter break?







# How much time would you estimate that you spend <u>studying or</u> <u>preparing for first-semester final exams</u> during the following times?






#### Level of Stress

## How do you rate your level of stress during a typical school week? (n=1,152)




# Compared with a typical school week, how do you rate your level of stress at the following times during December 2017 and January 2018? (n=1,152)

# During the most recent exam period, approximately how many of your course grades increased, stayed the same, and decreased following the final exam?





# What percentage of a student's grade should a semester final exam count for?





How much do you think ongoing coursework will interfere with first-semester final exam preparation if first-semester final exams are scheduled to be taken before Winter Break? (n=4,888)




How much will involvement in non-academic activities (school extracurriculars, family, etc.) interfere with first-semester final exam preparation? (n=4,900)

How much will involvement in non-academic activities (school extracurriculars, family, etc.) interfere with unit exam and project preparation just before Winter Break? (n=4,916)








#### What feeder school do you/does your child currently attend? (n=2,502)










# What grades level do you teach at Glenbrook High School District 225? Select all the apply. (n=458)


## Children Enrolled in Glenbrook Schools










## Which of the following best describes your role at Glenbrook High School? (n=606)


