Following our discussion on August 13, I made some further revisions to the proposed district initiatives. The following is a brief synopsis of the changes.

- 1. The "Employee Relations" section has been eliminated. We will continue to collect staff data for the Dashboard Reports, which was revised and expanded last year. Since we have basic survey results for staff from Workplace Dynamics, I feel it is best to avoid any further surveys until after the negotiations process has concluded. I will continue to pursue an alternative for determining administrative compensation in an appropriate manner. I do not feel that it needs to be a district initiative.
- 2. The "Curriculum-Related" section has been renamed "Curriculum and Instruction" to provide a better focus for the work to be completed and to make it easier to categorize the proposed initiatives in general.
- 3. The categories of "Environmental" and "Finance" have been combined under the new category of "Business."
- 4. The "Organizational Planning" category has been changed to "Human Resources." There are also some small revisions to the language of the initiatives.
- 5. "PR Communications" is now "PR and Communications" to indicate that there is a difference. Not all communications is PR. The idea of highlighting the community service efforts of the students will be incorporated within the branding campaign. It has already been highlighted on the school websites, but we will work to incorporate the message and ongoing recognition into the district brand.

Please note that by reorganizing and renaming some of the categories, they now align more closely to the major areas of responsibility for the assistant superintendents and directors in the District Office. Student wellness speaks more clearly to the buildings working in conjunction with the District Office.
