Attached you will find the list of textbook changes we are recommending for next year for Glenbrook North, Glenbrook South, and Glenbrook Academy of International Studies.

The requests have been reviewed by the teachers involved, the instructional supervisors and the associate principals. All attached requests are recommended for approval. Copies of the proposed textbooks will be available at the Board meeting for review on Monday, April 11, 2011. Kris Frandson, associate principal at Glenbrook North and Cameron Muir, associate principal at Glenbrook South will be at the meeting to assist in addressing Board questions as will instructional supervisors and the Director of the Glenbrook Academy. Note that Academy textbook proposals are contained within the GBS report (pp. 24-27) as the GBS bookstore orders Academy textbooks.

While this compilation reflects the majority of textbook changes, we may bring to the Board a limited number of texts in mid-summer, which reflect instructional decisions made during summer curriculum projects.

I recommend that the attached list be presented to the Board of Education for the Board's preliminary review at its meeting of April 11, 2011. It is my intention to resubmit the changes for Board approval at the regular Board meeting of April 25, 2011 on the consent agenda.

Attached you will find one document that summarizes the request for textbook adoptions for the 2011-2012 school year: *Textbook Change Summary 2011-2012*.

The GBN curriculum has continued to evolve through the Educational Planning Process, participation in articulation with sender schools, the availability of instructional technology components that accompany many new textbooks, student enrollment and changes in curricular programs. In light of these initiatives, come requests for changes in a few textbooks in world languages (2), social studies (1) and career and life skills (1). Continued development of our offerings in Hebrew necessitated the adoption of an additional text for the new third year course. The remaining textbooks proposed for adoption are due to publisher changes and availability of textbooks in world languages (1) and mathematics (1).
