FOIA Response:

Background:

The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA - 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) is a state statute that provides the public the right to access government documents and records. A person can ask a public body for a copy of its records on a specific subject and the public body must provide those records, unless there is an exemption in the statute that protects those records from disclosure (for example: records containing information concerning student records or personal privacy).

A public body must respond to a FOIA request within 5 business days after the public body receives the request or 21 business days if the request is for commercial purpose. That time period may be extended for an additional 5 business days from the date of the original due date if:

- The requested information is stored at a different location;
- The request requires the collection of a substantial number of documents;
- The request requires an extensive search;
- The requested records have not been located and require additional effort to find;
- The requested records need to be reviewed by staff who can determine whether they are exempt from FOIA;
- The requested records cannot be produced without unduly burdening the public body or interfering with its operations; or
- The request requires the public body to consult with another public body who has substantial interest in the subject matter of the request.

If additional time is needed, the public body must notify the requester in writing within 5 business days after the receipt of the request of the statutory reasons for the extension and when the requested information will be produced.

ATTACHED TO THIS EMAIL IS THE TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE AND RULES/REGULATIONS.

- * Thursday, April 26, 2018 games will take place at Glenbrook South High School (Glenview) and Glenbrook North High School (Northbrook).
- * Friday, April 27, 2018 games will take place at Glenbrook South High School (Glenview) and Techny Prairie Park (Northbrook).
- * Saturday, April 28, 2018 all games at Techny Prairie Park (Northbrook).
- ** If the fields are not playable due to inclement weather, then the schedule will be revised. Please be advised of this! We have the right to cancel matches if field conditions deteriorate. Winner bracket games will take precedent.

WEATHER

- * Thursday, April 26 61 high / 39 low, partly sunny
- * Friday, April 27 46 high / 37 low, storms
- * Saturday, April 28 57 high / 43 low, sunny

TIMING

2 x 40 minute halves. 10 minute halftime.

OVERTIME

If tied after regulation - 2 x 10 minute periods - sudden death "golden goal" format. Teams will immediately switch sides, no halftime/water breaks.

IHSA STATE SERIES PENALTY KICKS

If tied after overtime - best out of five penalty kicks will be taken. If tied after five penalty kicks, then sudden death format will be used to determine winner. All rostered players are eligible to participate in the taking of a penalty kick.

WARMUP/STARTING TIME FOLLOWING OVERTIME/PENALTY KICK OF PRIOR MATCH

Following an overtime match prior, the next two participating teams will be ensured a twenty (20) minute warm-up period. Administrators <u>may</u> and head coaches <u>can</u>, shorten the period, if necessary. It is advised that teams warm-up away from the fields to be more expedient to ensure proper warmup of players for their health while keeping the tournament close to schedule as possible for all involved.

- * 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place trophy cup will be awarded.
- * Twenty-eight (28) medals purchased for team placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.

* Seeding for next year's 2019 Glenbrook Cup will be based on this year's results. If a team does not come back, the tournament directors have the right to seed a team based on regular season scheduling to avoid duplication along with appropriate placing. We can not promise any duplication based on your regular season scheduling once advancement occurs throughout the tournament.

* Both high schools will have athletic trainers on-site. Furthermore, GBS/GBN athletic administration will be present to assist in any matters necessary for your convenience.

REMINDERS







Although I think both the boys and girls soccer programs are lucky to have our current situation where there is at least 1 coach at each level, I think it would be worth asking for the possibility of a goalkeeper coach stipend that could be evenly split between the boys and girls programs (similar to the pole-vaulting situation for track). With 1 coach at each lower level, it's difficult for our goalkeepers to get any development throughout the season unless their level coach is an experienced goalkeeper. If we each had a .5 stipend position to dedicate to goalkeepers, we could have them attend half of the days throughout the week and really help our goalkeepers get the training experience they need.

In the end, I understand this might be a lofty goal but I figured it would be worth trying.


