1) Experience and General Information

303 Taxi has been operating an “On Demand” taxi service on the Chicago North shore since 1946. The name “303” comes from the number on the call box at the Wilmette train station. Customers would dial 303 for service and the available drivers (parked nearby) would answer the Call box and dispatch themselves. Besides providing services for most of the senior “Dial-A-Ride” and PACE programs located in Lake, Cook, and DuPage counties. Our dispatch service has the exclusive responsibility for the dispatching of all City Of Chicago “Handicap Accessible Taxicabs” regardless of the company that owns it or the affiliation they are associated with.

For the past 29 years we have been providing transportation for “Special Needs Students” who attend schools in Lake, Cook, Dupage, McHenry, and Kane counties. 303 Taxi LLC currently has over 120 Illinois School Bus permitted drivers providing services that total in excess of 12,000 rides per month.

3) Driver Training

The training program that our drivers and returning drivers undergo is the same workshop that all drivers qualified to drive a school bus must participate in.

In order to become a school bus driver we require our drivers to do the following:

- All drivers are required to attend and complete an eight-hour safety class as required by the state of Illinois, in addition all returning drivers as well as those current drivers that 12-month has elapsed since last class are required to take and pass an additional refresher class.
- Be an Illinois licensed driver for three years or more.
- Have a good driving record.
- All drivers and returning drivers must undergo and pass a criminal background check.
- Initial drivers are required to file their fingerprints with their local police department.
- All driver and returning drivers must take and pass a physical exam and drug screen.
- After all prerequisites have been met, then our drivers must go to the Secretary of State to pass a test prior to school bus permit being issued.
- Some of our drivers and returning drivers are trained independently to operate wheelchair vehicles along with the procedures required to provide safe transportation to our non-ambulatory passengers.
- Our drivers are all trained in communication skills and how to use the equipment in each car.
- A question and answer session is provided to talk about all the listed guidelines.
- Some drivers receive additional training, this is usually a specialized training that pertains to the special needs associated with one passenger.

We have an Illinois certified “Defensive Driving” instructor on staff doing training out of our Chicago facility.

303 Taxi is one of the District’s current transportation vendors’; pricing on the submitted “Bid Form” is based on travel distances computed in miles and priced according to table below using discount levels based on current volume.

Please note that based on the unknown increased volume provided by others currently, we are extending an additional discount of 2% discount per \$10,000 spent over \$30,000 to the District. Example if the total bill for the month is over \$40k the District can take an additional 2% off the gross billing and 4% off if the total for the month is over \$50k when paying invoice.

Alternative to Zone Bid Proposal

The zone system was created out of a need to simplify transportation cost calculations before the advent of the many mapping tools that are so easily accessible today. 303 Taxi LLC would like to propose to School District 225 as part of its bid proposal an alternative that when compared to the Zone Based system will most often save in transportation costs.

Final Notes as Part of Bid

It has been our experience that providing transportation for special needs children can require a variety special services. In some cases we have been asked by our customers to wait extended periods of time at pickup or drop off points, provide assistance to/from the front door or to a class room, change routing from shortest distance to a route that best accommodates a caregiver's schedule among others.

Our Pricing is based on:

- a) Curb-to-Curb service whereas the driver remains with the vehicle at all times, pulls up in the morning and waits (X) minutes (usually 3-4 unless otherwise directed by Dist #225) before notifying the dispatcher to be released.
- b) We assume that there will be a caregiver at both pickup and drop off points to hand off and/or receive the child and that the only assistance the ambulatory child may need from the driver will be assistance with seat belts.
- c) Unless notified by the Home School to the contrary we assume that we will be able to share the vehicle with other District #225 students and build routes that make the most productive use of the transportation asset while minimizing total transportation mileage.
- d) We would also like to offer that with the specific permission of both Home School Districts that only have one student each going to a common Day School and their pickup addresses are within a 5 mile radius of each other, that we could share the vehicle while passing a 25% discount back to each district.

Special Needs/Requests... 303 Taxi can accommodate most special requests such as accessible vehicles for those students using different types of mobility devices, specialized harnesses or restraint devices and trained caregivers to accommodate most of a student's specialized needs.

Fuel...All pricing provided is based on reasonable and typical increases in costs, for the purpose of this Bid we are using as an average \$3.20 per gallon for regular un-leaded fuel in Cook County. If the 30 day average in cost of fuel would exceed \$3.60 per gallon it would be necessary to negotiate a fair and reasonable surcharge for the extra cost involved.

4. Glenbrook High School District 225, D/B.A Northfield Township High School District 225, was founded in 1947 and is comprised of two high schools. Glenbrook North High School serves 2,123 students residing in The Village of Northbrook and Glenbrook South High School serves 2,624 students residing primarily in The Village of Glenview. The district spends approximately \$500,000 annually for special education transportation. Transportation is required throughout the day to transport special education students to various locations in the community for work sites, field trips, etc. The district currently has approximately 150 students who avail themselves of transportation provided by the special education department.

Malicious Damage

District 225 shall not be liable for damage to vehicles caused by student vandalism, however, District 225 will assist contractor in seeking restitution for malicious damage to vehicles providing service to the District.

Schedules

Contractor will strictly adhere to the starting times and operating schedule for each route as established and agreed upon between District 225 and Vendor. It is expected that the same driver is assigned the same route each day and arrive and depart on time.

Insurance Requirements

Contractor and all vehicle operators shall carry, pay for and keep in force during the term of the contract and any extension thereof, in companies licensed to do business in Illinois with and A.M. Best rating of "A" and satisfactory to District 225. Commercial General Liability and Automobile Liability insurance policies (including physical damage) in minimum amounts of insurance as follows.

1. Combined single limit bodily injury and property damage coverage of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate.
2. Medical payment limits of \$5,000 each person, each occurrence.
3. Uninsured and underinsured motorist protection with limits no less than the minimum required by the State of Illinois for taxis.

Such insurance shall name District 225 as an additional insured on a primary and non-contributory basis. Contractual liability shall be provided under the Commercial General Liability policy includes the Hold Harmless Agreement as herein set out.

Each insurance company must agree not to terminate their coverage without thirty (30) days written notice to both District 225 and the Contractor and to include this clause in the insurance policy. In such case of termination, Contractor will provide to District 225 evidence of new insurance at the earliest possible date, but no later than ten days prior to the termination of the original policy.

Hold Harmless Agreement:

Contractor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend District 225, members of the Board of Education, officers, employees and agents thereof against all suits, actions, legal proceedings, claims and demands, and against all damages, losses, costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees, in any manner caused by, arising from, incident to, connected with, or growing out of the operation of the Contractor under performance of this transportation contract.

Workers' Compensation





4. Glenbrook High School District 225, D/B.A Northfield Township High School District 225, was founded in 1947 and is comprised of two high schools. Glenbrook North High School serves 2,123 students residing in The Village of Northbrook and Glenbrook South High School serves 2,624 students residing primarily in The Village of Glenview. 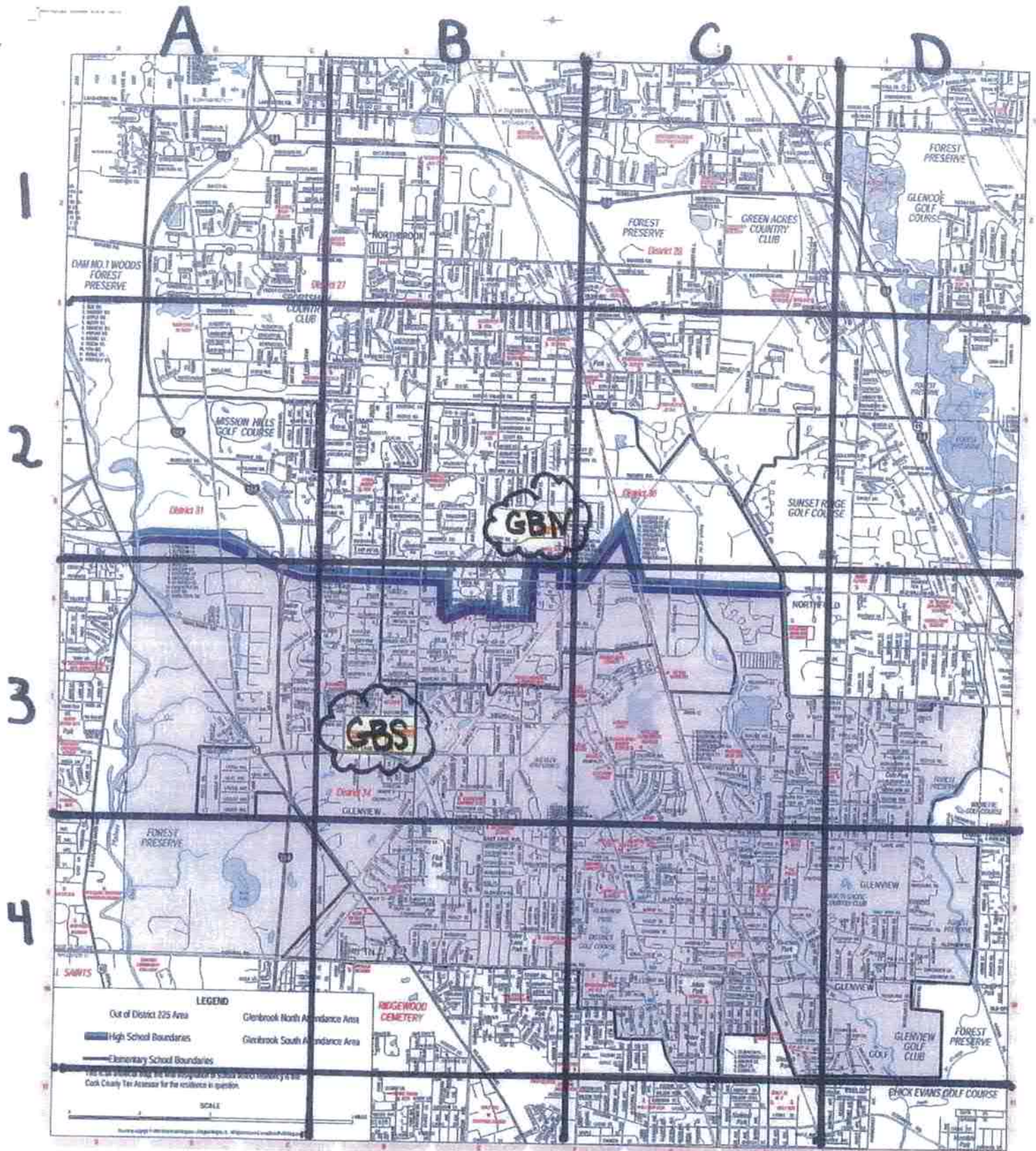


