NOTICE OF FILING PETITIONS FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION TO BOARD OF EDUCATION, HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT #225, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

The election for members of the Board of Education for Northfield Township High School District No. 225 will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2009. Nominating petitions and other necessary documents may be filed beginning Tuesday, January 20, 2009, through Monday, January 26, 2009, in the Office of the Secretary of the Board of Education, Northfield Township High School District No. 225, 1835 Landwehr Road, Glenview, IL 60026, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on any day from Monday through Friday, except on Monday, January 26, 2009 when the petitions may be filed between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

At the April 7, 2009 election there will be four Board members elected to full terms.

Nominating petitions must be signed by at least fifty voters residing within the high school district. Petitions, forms, and other necessary documents for filing may be obtained from the Office of the Secretary of the Board of Education of Northfield Township High School District No. 225 at the above address between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. daily, except for school holidays.
