At the Board meeting on Tuesday, November 12, we will recognize Glenbrook South High School for being selected for the Secretary of State Jesse White 2013 Teen Driving Safety Award.

To honor the accomplishment, 11 students and four teachers and administrators travelled to the James R. Thompson Center in Chicago on Wednesday, October 23 to receive a special presentation from the Secretary.

In a press conference, White explained how GBS's innovative teaching techniques have contributed to a nearly 60 percent decrease in teen driving death in the state of Illinois.

Representatives from the Secretary of State's office presented the award to the school during the Veteran's Day Assembly on Thursday, November 7.
