We will be recognizing national writing award winners as well as the organizers of the Glenbrook North Goes Pink fundraiser.

The National Council of Teachers of English annually awards students across the nation for excellence in writing. A total of 30 Illinois high school seniors were named NCTE winners, and a total of 525 students were honored nationwide. This year, two Glenbrook students were honored with the award: Kalli Angel from GBN and Corinne Chin from GBS.

The Glenbrook North Goes Pink fundraiser raised over \$7,000 for breast cancer awareness and research. Twelve hundred "GBN goes pink ... together we can save lives." T-shirts were sold. Students wore the shirts to school October 3 and also to the GBS vs. Highland football game, where GBN students were resplendent in pink instead of green and gold.
